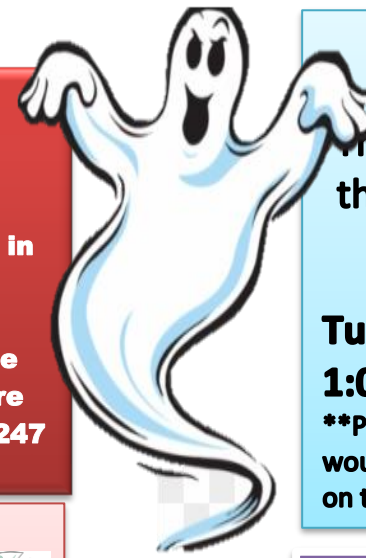


- 16. Every resident has the right to proper accommodation, nutrition, care and services consistent with their needs.

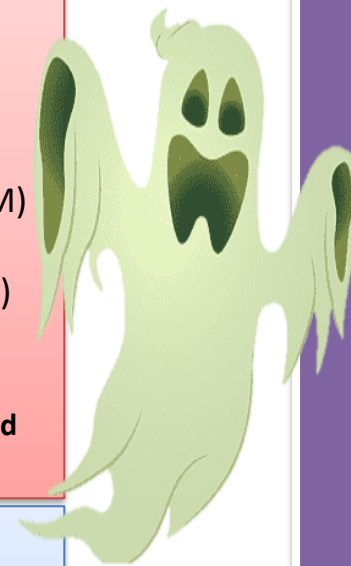
